



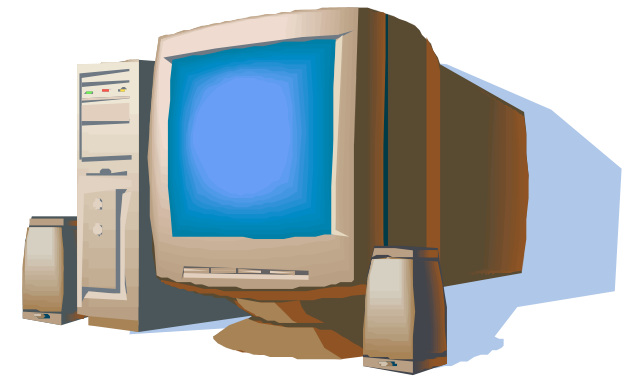

Mount Eliza North Primary School presents a range of technologies to support student learning. These technologies encompass a range of media, tools, environments and resources including rich, interactive, online resources.

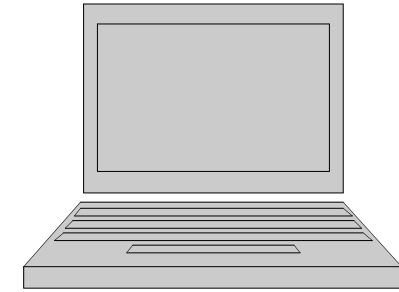
eLearning creates engaging learning opportunities and acts as a catalyst for authentic, meaningful learning experiences.
