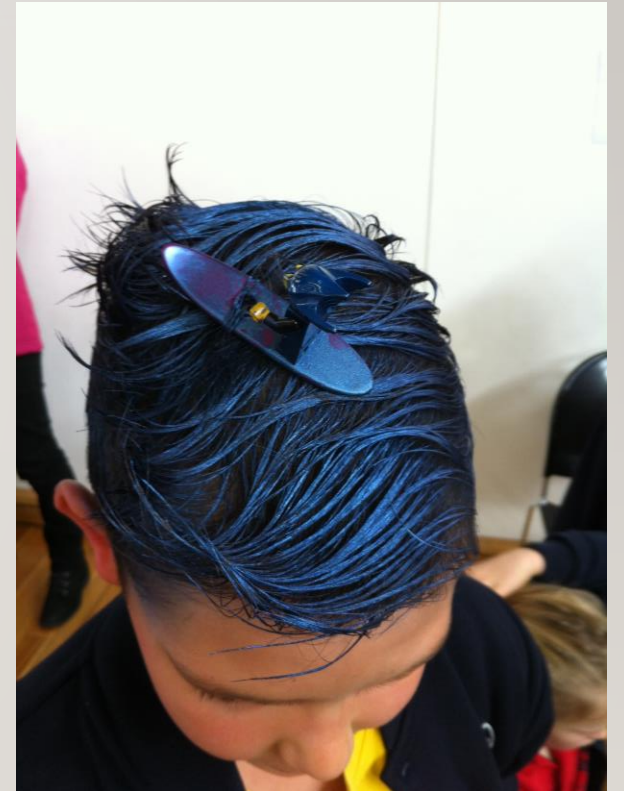


# Crazy Hair Day
